In addition to learning critical financial literacy skills, participants are empowered to use their unique skillsets in innovative ways to create meaningful employment opportunities. Through the program, participants increase their confidence and knowledge of financial literacy, learn about freelance work, entrepreneurship and working remotely to broaden their scope of employment opportunities.



LEARNING OUTCOMES

Through the program:

- Participants identify their money mindset and their personal definition of financial independence;
- Participants implement strategies to bolster their income through freelancing, entrepreneurship or remote work;
- Participants adopt practical techniques to become more financially independent;
- Participants identify workforce trends and the skillsets required to thrive in the future economy.

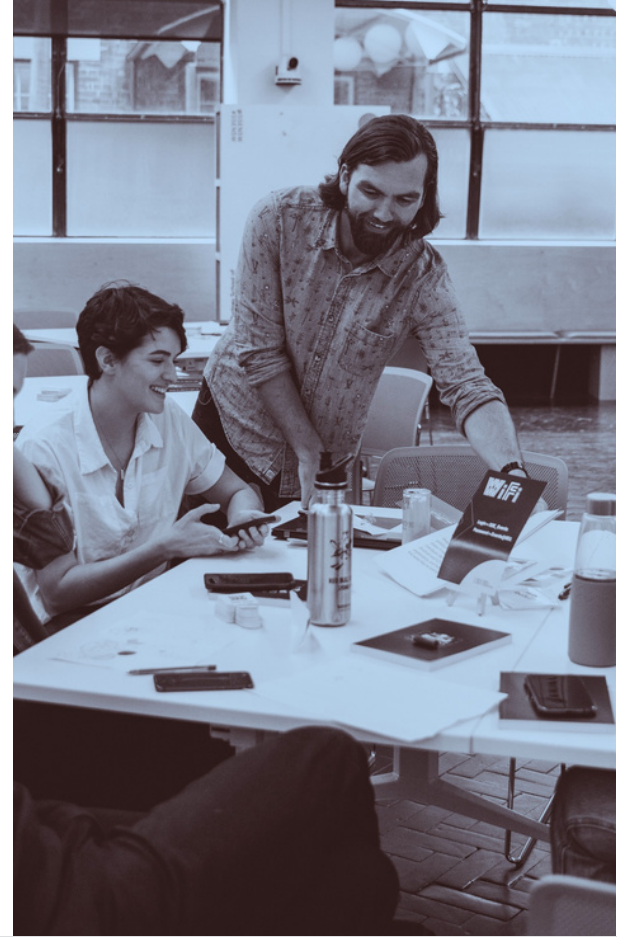

Participants work through four modules to complete Creating Your Financial Future on SSE's Learning Management System 'SSEQuad' and are supported through mentoring sessions.

Each of the modules is designed to contribute to the skills growth journey of the participants.

Money Mindset

Participants understand how they view money and how that affects their financial goals. They will learn about the different sources of income and the important factors to consider.

Understanding Freelancing

Participants understand more about their strengths and weaknesses and how they might be able to use these in freelancing to pursue an alternative career path.

Understanding Entrepreneurship

Participants learn about the skillsets and mindsets that create successful entrepreneurs and how this career path might influence their financial goals.

Becoming Entrepreneurs

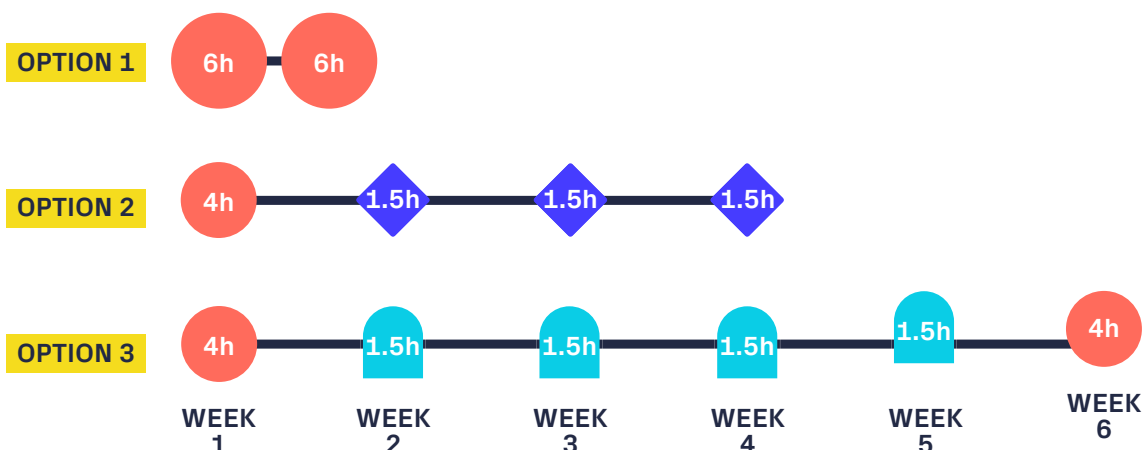
Participants identify an entrepreneurial opportunity of interest and develop a plan on how to pursue it, working to develop the skills and mindsets needed to create a business of their own.

PROGRAM DETAILS

Creating Your Financial Future brings together financial literacy and entrepreneurship for participants. It is an SSE-led and facilitated program with a customisable delivery model that can be integrated into youth programs and school curriculum. Supported by a Learning Management System, SSE's facilitators provide support and individualised feedback to ensure a quality experience for participants.

- Entrepreneurial plan: at the end of the program, participants have developed an individualised plan about how they could use entrepreneurship to bring an innovation to life, and consequently, create an alternative source of income.
- Guest speakers: throughout the program, industry mentors act as role models, providing relatable industry-specific information and life stories.
